General Information and Policies

The purpose of Camp Wagging Tails is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs. To ensure the safety and health of your camper, we require all campers and their guardians to comply with the following camp rules:

Age: All Campers must be at least 16 weeks old and completed the 4th round of puppy shots

Sex: All Campers 6 months or older must be spayed or neutered

Vaccinations: All Campers must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof of Rabies, DHLPP (distemper), Bordetella (canine cough) and a negative fecal test. **Bordatella must be done every 6 months.**

Fleas: All Campers must be free of fleas and on a **monthly flea prevention program such as Comfortis, Trifexis (chewable pills), Frontline Plus, Vectra or Advantix (topical treatments)**. All Campers will be checked for fleas. Arrivals with fleas will be bathed and treated at their owner's expense (a minimum of \$70)

Heartworm: All Campers must be on a **monthly heartworm prevention program such as Interceptor, Heartguard, Trifexis or Sentinel**

Pick Up: No one will be allowed to pick up your Camper unless they are listed in the camper's profile. A signature and proof of ID is required.

Health: All campers must be in good health. Guardians will certify that their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. If the camper has had a communicable condition within the last 30 days, we will require a Veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or re-admitted. Upon admission to camp, all campers must be free from any condition, which could potentially jeopardize other campers.

Behavior: All campers must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Guardians will certify that their camper has not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember that your camper will be spending time with other campers and the safety and health of all campers is our main concern.

Applications: All Campers must have a complete, up-to-date and approved application on file. There is a one time, free, evaluation required for each Camper.

Days and Hours of Operation:

- Monday-Friday the Front Office is open 7:00 AM-6:30 PM.
Drop-off is between 7-11:00am or 1:30-4.00pm.
Pick-up is between 7-11:00am or 1:30-6:30 pm.

No drop off or pick up between 11AM-1:30 PM as it is nap time.

- Saturday and Sunday pick-up and drop-off is between 8-10 AM and 3-5 PM.

Any camper not picked up by closing time will be checked in for overnight camp and charged the appropriate rate.

Reservations: Are required. Credit card (Mastercard and Visa only) required at time of reservation to hold reservation.

Cancellation Policy:

Day Camp: should you need to cancel, please just call to let us know.

Overnight Camp: Must be cancelled no later than 7:00am two (2) days prior to scheduled arrival day. **If the reservation is cancelled after that time, a \$25 per dog cancellation fee will be charged.**

Holidays: Cancellations or changes must occur at least 7 days prior to scheduled arrival, otherwise you will be charged for your original stay. Holidays are: New Years, Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.



Check-In Guide

Leashes & Collars

- All campers must be restrained (on leash) before entering & departing lobby.
- Quick release or snap collar required; no buckle collar.

Vaccinations

DOGS:

1. Rabies
2. Distemper/Parvo
3. Bordatella - every 6 months

CATS:

1. Rabies
2. FVRCP (feline distemper)
3. Feline Leukemia

Flea Prevention/Heartworm Prevention

- All guests must be on a monthly flea preventative such as Comfortis, Trifexis (chewable pill), Frontline Plus, Vectra or Advantix (topicals) for dogs. Revolution or Advantage for cats.
- All dogs must be on a monthly heartworm preventative such as Interceptor, Heartguard, Trifexis or Sentinel.

Food

- Meals are to be pre-packaged in Ziploc baggies for each dog per each meal.
- **No bags of food or large containers allowed.**
- Bowls are provided by Camp Wagging Tails, no need to bring your own.

Medications

All medication **MUST** be in the original container, whether prescription or OTC. Prescription medications must clearly show pet's name, medication strength and dosage.

Toys & Belongings

- Bedding and towels are provided by Camp Wagging Tails, no need to bring your own.
- No bones/rawhides/pig ears/Greenies.

- Reservations are needed for day camp.
- Playgroups run from 7am – 11am and 1:30pm – 3pm.
- Drop off time is 7am – 9am

Overnight Camp Cancellation Policy

- Reservations must be cancelled no later than 7am two(2) days prior to scheduled arrival day. **If the reservation is cancelled after that time, a \$25 per dog cancellation fee will be charged** (See website or call us for holiday cancellation policy)

I understand that I am solely responsible for any harm or damage caused by my dog(s) to persons or property of the Owners, employees, licensees, invitees of Camp Wagging Tails, or any other pets housed or visiting Camp Wagging Tails while my dog(s) is/are attending Camp Wagging Tails Day and Overnight Camp.
- ___ 2. I further understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s) to the camp, Camp Wagging Tails' staff have relied on my representation that my dog(s) is/are in good health and have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog.
- ___ 3. I further understand and agree that Camp Wagging Tails LLC, and their staff and volunteers, will not be liable for any problems which develop, provided reasonable care and precautions are followed, and I hereby release and discharge them of any and all damages, liability and/or causes of action of any kind of accident, damage or injury whatsoever arising from my dog(s) attendance and participation at the camp.
- ___ 4. I further understand, consent and agree that any problem or injury that develops with my dog(s) while under the control of Camp Wagging Tails will be treated by my own vet. In the event my own vet is not available or too far away, I agree to let the vets and staff at North Mecklenburg Animal Hospital, Lake Cross Veterinary or Carolina Veterinary Specialists (Animal Emergency Hospital) treat my dog or cat. I agree to assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved in such treatment.
