When should I arrive?

- 7 - 9 am MON - FRI
- 8 - 9 am SAT & SUN

When should I be picked up?

- 1:30 - 6:30 pm MON - FRI
- 3 - 5 pm SAT & SUN

Do my humans need to make a reservation for me to play?

Yes, please call ahead to make sure we have room for you, especially if it's a last minute decision.

What do I need before I can come play?

You will need to be on a monthly Flea Preventative and Heartworm Preventative. You will also need a quick disconnect collar (no martingales or pinch collars).

How much time do I get to play?

Several hours in the morning and several hours in the afternoon. We take into account weather conditions and safety of all dogs playing each day.

What if I get tired?

After coming in from morning play group, Camp Wagging Tails Pet Professionals tuck everyone in for a nap 11 - 1pm each day. We will also offer Campers more quiet time indoors if there are health or safety concerns.

Should I bring anything?

If you normally eat lunch at home, please remind Mom or Dad to bring it in a sealed bag or container so you can eat lunch before your naptime.
